Julie Vaughan-Graham M.C.S.P., PT, M.Sc (cand); Advanced IBITA Instructor; graduated from St. Thomas' Hospital, London, England in 1986. Julie has worked in the area of neurorehabilitation since 1988, and has a special interest in the rehabilitation of the incomplete spinal cord injured individual. Julie emigrated to Toronto in 1991, initially taking a position at Lyndhurst, Spinal Cord Injury Centre, and then later opening her own private community neurorehabilitation practice, Physio-Logic, in Toronto in 1993. Julie qualified as an IBITA Bobath Instructor in 2000 and as an Advanced IBITA Bobath Instructor in 2008. Julie is currently enrolled in an M.Sc. 'The Bobath concept' at Leeds Metropolitan University, Leeds, UK, and is in her final year completing her dissertation on 'Clinical Reasoning and the Expert Bobath Therapist'. Julie maintains a clinical caseload at her private practice in Toronto, and provides one on one clinical mentorship on a consult basis to physiotherapists and occupational therapists. Julie has a Status-only Instructor status with the University of Toronto. She instructs post-graduate clinical Bobath courses across Canada and Internationally.

Course Description:

This course is an introductory level course to expose the course participant to the treatment and management of the hemiplegic upper limb based on the principles of the Contemporary Bobath Concept and an understanding of human movement. The course will consist of lectures, patient demonstrations and practical sessions. The following topics will be explored and discussed:

- Musculoskeletal review of the shoulder girdle and upper limb with respect to hemiplegia
- The painful hemiplegic shoulder; causes and intervention
- Neural control of upper limb function
- Plasticity and expectations for functional recovery of the upper limb
- Critical review of the current research findings with respect to upper limb recovery and treatment following stroke.

Course Objectives:

- The Course participant will gain an understanding of:
- The relationship between musculoskeletal alignment and movement control.
 - The role of sensation and motor control of the hemiplegic upper limb.
 - The relationship between plasticity and functional recovery of the upper limb.
